# 2021 College Scholarship – David Ballard Scholarship

# **Scholarship Description:**

The BTSC (Behind the Scenes Club) is a volunteer organization, made up of parents of CHS Performing Arts Students. BTSC supports the drama and technical theater departments at Carmel High School. Each year, BTSC awards one-time college scholarships to Carmel High School seniors. The David Ballard scholarship is intended to recognize students who have participated in the CHS drama, technical theatre and film programs that plan to pursue non theater related majors. Seniors who have participated as performers or as members of the technical crew are encouraged to apply.

The number and amount of the scholarship can vary each year depending on BTSC funds available and the number and quality of the applicants.

The BTSC Scholarship Committee will review all applications. The Scholarship Committee will consist of BTSC Board members and/or other individuals as designated by the Board. BTSC members who are related by blood or marriage to a scholarship applicant are not eligible to serve on the BTSC Scholarship Committee.

## **Application Requirements:**

In order to apply for the CHS BTSC Scholarship, you must meet ALL of the following criteria:

- Be a Carmel High School graduating senior.
- Have been admitted to an accredited, post-secondary school (university, college or trade school) or have applied and are waiting on acceptance.
- Be a member of the International Thespian Society.
- Have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher.
- Have completed or are currently enrolled in an advanced-level drama or technical theater course.
- Submit completed application by the end of school (3:30 pm) on or before the deadline of **April 16**<sup>th</sup>,**2021**.

#### Selection Criteria:

Each scholarship will be awarded based on a strong and complete application which includes the minimum requirements listed above and the following:

- Number of CHS theater department performances (as an actor or crew member), including Indy Fringe and Spring Musical.
- Number of leadership roles held (A "leadership role" includes: Crew Lead/Head or Crew Co-Lead/Head, Student Director, Assistant Director, Board Member and/or Officer of Rising Stars and/or Thespian Society).
- Number of Thespian points accumulated by the deadline of the application.
- Awards received for film, crew or performance.
- GPA (as calculated on your mid-year, end of semester report card).
- Positive contributions at CHS within the drama/technical theater program as recommended by the faculty.

# **How to Apply:**

- Complete a BTSC Scholarship Application.
- Submit the application with all requirement attachments to Mr. Jim Peterson by the deadline.

Deadline for Application is Friday, April 16, 2021. Scholarships will be awarded at The Rising Stars Banquet.

Include leadership positions within those productions and USITT/ Rising Stars/Thespian Society, if applicable. Points will only be awarded for technical/crew participation in choir performances/concerts as these performances are required for all choir students.
- A short essay (no more than one typed page) explaining how you have positively contributed to the CHS Drama and Technical Theater Department(s). In this essay, explain why you are continuing in your theatrical studies in college.
